Re NHS Test & Trace App  
24 September 2020

Dear Member,

The Government has requested that ALL hospitality businesses, including our Club, use the new NHS Test & Trace App. This is to ensure that members and visitors can be traced in the event that someone visiting the Club subsequently develops Covid-19.

As from today, 24th September, you will therefore see posters at the Club asking you to sign in using the NHS Test & Trace QR code.

To do this you will firstly need to download the NHS Test and Trace App to your phone. You can do this using one of these links.

Once you have this downloaded and set up, all you need to do when you arrive at the Club is open it, click 'Venue Check-In' then hold the camera up to the poster. Your time of entry is then instantly recorded.

For those of you who are yet to download the NHS App, or are unable to do so, we are leaving our own QR poster up in a few areas. There is also a sign in book provided inside the Clubhouse for anybody without a smartphone.

You should use one of these methods to sign in every time you visit the Club to help us keep all members and visitors safe and healthy.

Our bar staff will ask you to confirm that you have signed in by using one of the options available. Anyone refusing to sign in may be asked to leave the premises.

Please remember not to come to the Club if you or anybody in your household has a persistent cough, fever, or are suffering from loss of smell or taste.



Your assistance in helping us do everything we possibly can to keep this virus at bay, and away from our Club, is very much appreciated.
