Roadmap to Re-opening Tennis & Squash
26 February 2021

Dear Member,

Tennis Courts

Following the announcement by the Prime Minister on Monday I am delighted to announce we will be re-opening the tennis courts on Monday 29th March for both singles and doubles play. The current rules on social distancing will continue to apply so please do maintain at least 2 metres social distancing, use sanitiser on both entering and leaving the club, and please do not linger before or after your game.

Coaching

1:1 coaching will resume on Monday 29th March and squad coaching will resume after the Easter holidays on Monday 12th April.

Bar & Catering Services

The roadmap provided by the Prime Minister gives up hope that we will be able to resume outdoor bar and catering services as from Monday 12th April and indoor bar and catering services as from Monday 17th May. We also plan to re-open bar & catering services in the mornings as well as the evenings. Unfortunately, re-opening of the clubhouse will come too late for the Seniors ITF Tournament in May, so this has now been cancelled.

Squash

The Government has announced that the plan is to re-open indoor leisure (including gyms), for use individually or within household bubbles, as from Monday 12th April, so we are hopeful that a return to squash can commence on that date. Organised indoor sport is scheduled to re-open on Monday 17th May so we hope that play between households can resume then. As ever, timings are subject to change, depending on whether or not pre-conditions set by the Government for re-opening have been met. We will, of course, provide further clarification once we receive it.
